### American Revolution Historical Trivia

There were 2 Boston Tea Parties!  
Everyone knows how 50 or 60 "Sons of Liberty,"  
disguised as Mohawks, protested the 3 cents per pound  
British tax on tea by dumping chests of the drink into  
Boston Harbor on December 16, 1773. Fewer know that  
Bostonians repeated the performance on March 7, 1774.  
The two tea parties cost the British around \$3 million in  
modern money.

### New Law in AZ Effective Jan 1, 2009

ARS 28-2354 has changed regarding your automobile  
license plate holders. The law requires the plate to **be  
legible and so that the name of this state at the  
top of the license plate is not obscured.** You can  
have a license plate holder/frame as long as it doesn't  
obscure or hide the name "Arizona" on your license  
plate. So if you have a frame holder that covers the name  
Arizona on your license plate, remove it before Jan 1, 2009,  
and reattach your plate without a frame, or with a frame that  
doesn't cover the name "Arizona." Sorry, I believe our SAR  
License Plate Frame may no longer work at least in AZ. For
