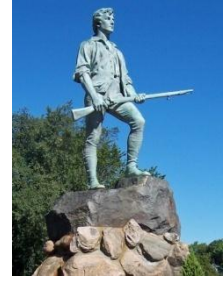




# TUCSAR BUGLE
